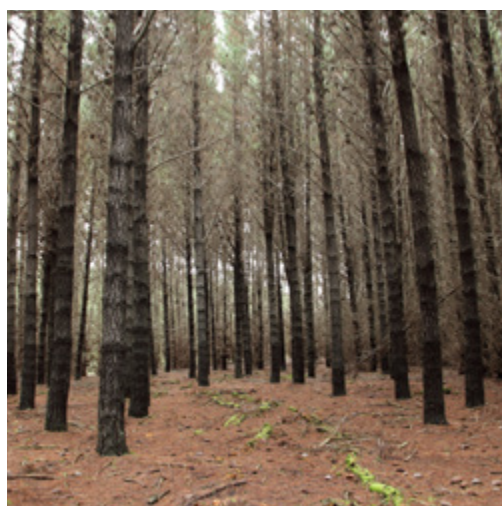
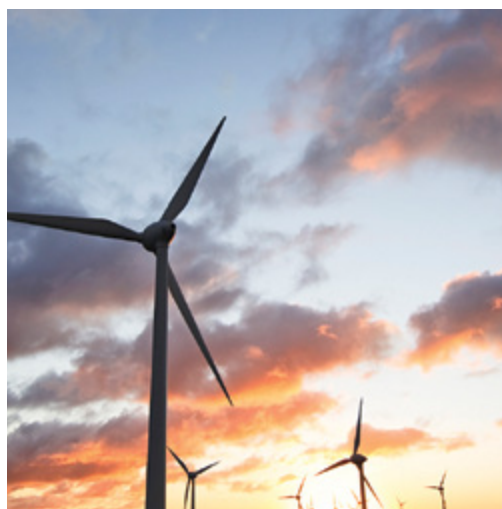

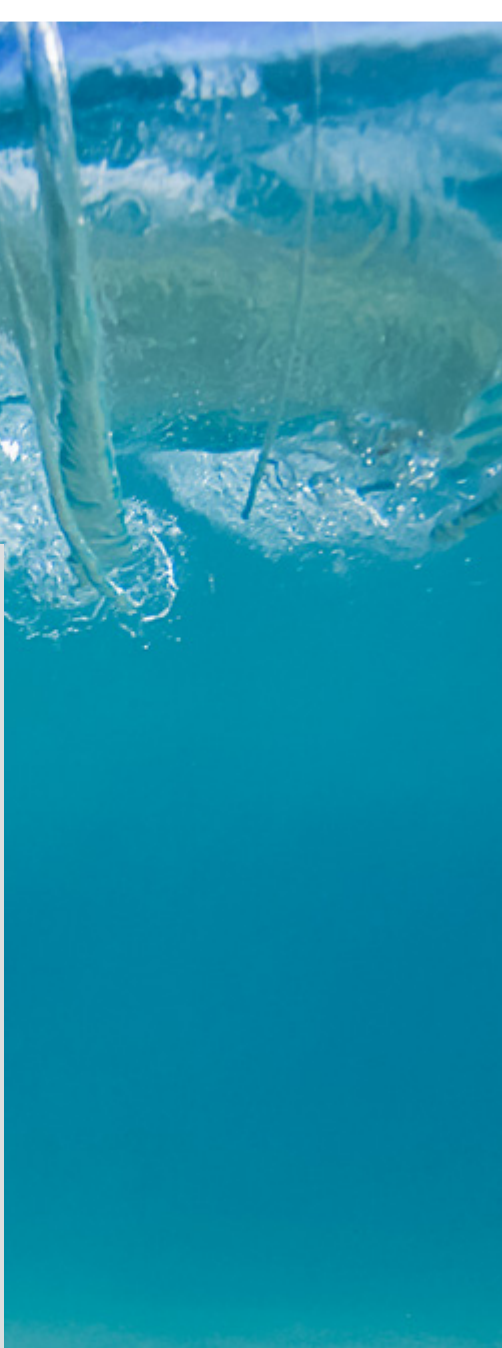
Gold Sponsor A\$15,000
